# MUBENDE DISTRICT LOCAL GOVERNMENT JOINT MOCK RESULTS AUGUST, 2024.

Introduction.

The 2024 District Joint Mock Examinations were planned through a comprehensive roadmap involving various stakeholders. The process began with a preparation up to dissemination of results.

The examinations were conducted from August 14<sup>th</sup> to16<sup>th</sup>, 2024 at respective schools with UNEB centres, overseen by the DEO's Office and CAO. Marking took place from August 26<sup>th</sup> to 31<sup>th</sup> August 2024, at Kaweeri District Model Primary School, involving the District Examination Board, UNEB Examiners, selected District Examiners and the DEO's Office.

The results are now ready to be released and disseminated to different stakeholders.

# Registered Candidates.

Mubende District registered a total of 5626 candidates from 122 schools whereby, 87 are Government Aided schools and 35 are Private Schools.

3618 Candidates were from Government/UPE schools and 2008 from private schools representing 64.3% and 35.7% respectively of which 3,049 of the candidates were female and 2,577 were male, representing 54.2% and 45.8% respectively.

The table above shows that only 274(4.9%) candidates scored grade I,214(21.6%) candidates scored grade II, 619(11.0%) grade III, 1,528 (27.2%) grade IV, 1,851 (32.9%) were ungraded and140(2.5%) were absent. Kitokota Primary School had the highest number of absentees with 20 candidates followed by Muyinayina Primary School with 7, Precious Learning Centre with 6 and Kasaana Public Primary school 5 candidates.

### **OBSERVATIONS:**

- (i) A total of 5,626 candidates sat for the MOCK exams, with 64.6% passing(Divisions 1-4) and 35.4% failing. Additionally, 140 pupils missed some or all of the exam papers.
- (ii) Out of 2,008 private candidates, 79.9% passed, with 11.2% in Division 1, 33.3% in Division 2, 10.7% in Division 3, and 24.8% in Division 4. About 20.1% of private pupils failed the exam.
- (iii) Among 3,618 UPE candidates, 56.1% passed, while 43.9% failed. Only 1.4% passed in Division 1, and the majority of candidates passed in lower divisions.
- (iv) Out of 3,049 female candidates, 63.6% passed and 36.4% failed. Only 3.7% achieved Division 1, while a larger portion, 29%, passed in Division 4.
- (v) Among 2,577 male candidates, 65.8% passed, while 34.2% failed. Males performed slightly better than females, with 6.2% in Division 1.
- (vi) Males performed better overall, with 65.8% passing, compared to 63.6% of females.
- (vii) Kyenda Town Council was the best-performing Lower Local Government, with 45.3% of its candidates passing in Divisions 1 and 2 and 83% overall.
- (viii) Kasambya Town Council had the best UPE performance, with 35.6% of candidates passing in Divisions 1 and 2, and 70.6% passing overall.
- (ix) Nabingoola Town Council had the best private school performance, with 70.1% of candidates passing in Divisions 1 and 2, and 88% overall.
- (x) Kiruuma was the worst-performing Lower Local Government, with 4.8% of its candidates passing in Divisions 1 and 2, followed by Butoloogo with 9.2% and 74% and 52.3% failure respectively.
- (xi) Kiruuma had the worst UPE performance, with 5.2% of its candidates passing in Divisions 1 and 2, followed by Kayebe with 5.4% and 73.4% and 59.5% failure respectively.
- (xii) Kiruuma had the worst private school performance, with 0.0% of its candidates passing in Divisions 1 and 2, followed by Butoloogo with 11.5% and 91.7% and 38.5% failure respectively.
- (xiii) The district's performance has significantly improved from 32.41% in 2019 to 64.6% in 2024.
- (xiv) English had the highest number of distinctions (8.1%), followed by

- Mathematics (9.6%), while Science was the lowest-performed subject, with only 2.1% passing with distinctions.
- (xv) The best performing candidates were Muhwezi Jonathan, Matovu Joel, Matovu Mustafah and Ashiimwe Miracle who scored aggregates 4 and all from New Life Preparatory School. The best performing UPE candidates were Tugabirwe Prudance and Mbabazi Gift Ritah who scored aggregate 5 and all from Buwaata PS.

#### STRATEGIES TO IMPROVE PERFORMANCE:

- (i) Subject based teacher trainings/workshops at Centre / School level with UNEB examiners be organized.
- (ii) Results and examiners' reports be used by schools to make revision using the identified concepts that were not well grasped.
- (iii) Every School to come up with school performance improvement plan.
- (iv) Head teachers to account for candidates who never sat for mock examinations to the District Education Officer within one week after the release of exams and the DEO to give a report to the Chief Administrative Officer on the same within 14 days after the release of the exams with strategies to reduce on the absenteeism.
- (v) UPE schools should receive additional support to improve their performance, especially targeting the high failure rates and absenteeism.
- (vi) Efforts should be made to improve Science performance, given that it was the lowest-performing subject.
- (vii) Schools should focus on pushing more candidates from Division 4 into Divisions 1 and 2, ensuring a more even distribution of successful candidates.

# **CONCLUSION:**

The overall performance of the district in the 2024 MOCK examinations shows significant improvement compared to previous years. Private schools outperformed UPE schools, with private candidates achieving a higher passing rate. Males performed slightly better than females. Kyenda Town Council was the best among sub-counties for overall performance, while Kasambya Town Council led in UPE schools, and Nabingoola Town Council led in private school performance. English was the most done subject, with Science being the least.

There is much hope for the best performance in the forthcoming PLE if the suggested strategies are implemented.
